Animeleague Event Terms and Conditions

By registering for this event, you agree to the following terms, conditions, refunds policy, and privacy statement. If in the event any of these policies are broken, we reserve the right to ban you from future events and to take further action if we deem it appropriate -

1. While all ages can attend, you must be the age of 16 or over to attend by yourself. Under 16s must have an adult accompanying. Under 18s cannot attend past 8pm. We will ask you for ID if we believe you are under 16. For access to 18+ events and activities you MUST bring a valid proof of ID which includes a passport, citizens card or driving license (can be provisional). We will accept out of date proofs of ID provided the photos is recognisably you.
2. You recognize that you will need your ticket or a proof of your identity to be granted entry.
3. You recognize that the organisers have the right to refuse entry to any member who registers who has appeared on a banned list from any other UK anime convention and have the power to remove any member from the convention at their own discretion.
4. You recognize that with regards to floor cosplay weapons the organisers have the final say and can remove it from you and placed in ops where it can be picked up for Masquerade use only and when you leave the convention. Please read our rules regarding cosplay weapons [HERE](#).
5. You agree to abide by our code of conduct (see below).
6. If you take photographs/videos that focus on a specific person or group then you make sure to ask them beforehand and they and us reserve the right to request you remove them. Any photos and videos you take and publish on site, you agree we can use for promotional purposes provided we credit you and your website.
7. If you attend the event to write a blog or review, we have the right to request for you to take it down if it is deemed slanderous or inappropriate.
8. We do not send physical copies of tickets. Once you purchase your ticket you will be emailed a confirmation immediately along with your e-ticket. You print this out and bring this along with a proof of ID to pick up your wristband, which gives you entry, on the day of the event.
9. You agree to our refunds policy.
10. You agree to our privacy policy.
11. We reserve the right to amend these terms and conditions and policies at any time. If we do so then we will inform you of any changes if you are booked in for an event where these new rules will go into effect.

Code of Conduct Policy

We aim to create a safe space at our events. For this reason, we ask for our attendees to follow this code of conduct;

1. Treat Each other with respect - including but not limited to deliberately antagonizing others, creating excessive noise, inappropriate behaviour toward others, spreading drama and so forth.
2. No Threats or Bullying - You will not threaten nor bully another member in any way, be it through violence or non-violent means.
3. No Harassment - If someone asks you to leave them alone then abide by this. Do not keep approaching them or this constitutes harassment.
4. Alcohol, responsible drinking and food - Drink responsibly, if you get very drunk and start being disruptive then you will be warned for this. Drinking should also be done by 18+ only (any underage drinking will NOT be tolerated). Alcohol will be served by the venue - you may not bring in outside alcohol to the venue. For some venues, outside food is also not allowed - please check the website where we will state if this is OK or not.
5. The Law - It goes without saying that anything that breaks the law is a definite NO. Theft, assault and so forth will result in you being immediately banned from the meet.

- For lesser offences you will receive one warning. A second warning and you will be told to leave the event without a refund and will likely be banned from future events.

- For more serious offences that break the law such as sexual harassment, actual violence, drug abuse/dealing, you will be immediately banned and removed from the event and authorities will be contacted if deemed necessary.

Refunds Policy

You agree that the event reserves the right to not provide a refund. All refunds, cancellations and amendments are entirely at the organiser's discretion regardless of time-frame. If it is agreed to provide a refund then a £10 administration fee on entry and a further £10 on accommodation will be applied as a minimum.

- We will allow you to transfer your membership from yourself to someone else at no cost up to one week beforehand.

- One month prior to the event refunds will not be provided regardless of organiser discretion. Transfers will not be provided from one week beforehand.

Our Privacy Statement

We will only collect and use the information submitted by you via this website for the purposes of running the event. We will not pass on your details to any third party without your consent.

We are committed to ensuring that all your personal data including that of a sensitive nature is used with your consent, respect for your privacy and only for the purpose of our legal obligations and for the running of the event. This also accords with our legal obligations under the Data Protection Act 1998.

Any personal information which you supply (with the exception of your email address which will be used for your account and marketing purposes) will be removed within a reasonable time after the event has taken place. If you wish to remove any personal information (including your email address) from our system before the event, please email us at registrations@animeleague.com. An unsubscribe link will be added to any promotional emails to allow you to opt-out of further promotional emails.
